GONDWANA GAME RESERVE

Set on 11,000-hectares of undulating valleys and indigenous Fynbos, the Gondwana Game Reserve is the first authentic free-roaming Big Five reserve in the Western Cape, and home to several endangered wild species including Cape Mountain Zebra, Black Rhinoceros, and Black Harrier.

Accommodation at Gondwana ranges from open-plan suites in Kwena Lodge, a clever twist on traditional Khoi-San dwelling; to spacious Afro chic Fynbos and Bush Villas with choices of 2, 3 and 4 en-suite bedrooms. Guests are treated to surprise bush breakfasts, afternoon romantic picnics, evening barbecues and sundowners at scenic spots.

The Kwena and Lehele Restaurants serve authentic South African cuisine in outdoor or boma style, while the spa offers natural penair treatments with Africology products.



Pinnacle Point Golf Course Mossel Bay, Garden Route Par 72 | Hole 18 | 6465 m

The Pinnacle Point Golf Course, co-designed by renowned golf architect Peter Matkovich and British Open champion Darren Clarke, stretches along four kilometers of spectacular coastline and boasts dramatic cliff-side holes as well as a virgin beachfront. Awe inspiring views are a given with the stunning ocean visible from every hole on what has been aptly called as South Africa's response to the hallowed Pebble Beach.

The emerald green fairways and tees offer a perfect surface for making shots and the bent grass greens will ensure a challenging and entertaining game. The seven holes perched precariously along the cliff edge not only intimidate but also seduce the golfer with both their challenges and their beauty and are justifiably some of the world's most photographed holes.

Most golfers immediately associate Pinnacle Point when relating to golf along the famous Garden Route, making it a must play when in the area.







Mossel Bay Golf Estate Golf Course Mossel Bay, Garden Route Par 72 | Hole 18 | 5940 m

One of the must play courses on the Garden Route, Mossel Bay is famous for stunning views of the Indian Ocean from every tee as well as the marvelous bird and animal life such as the springbok that sometimes roam into play, leaving you spellbound.

Designed originally by Bob Grimsdell, the course layout was redesigned by Danie Obermeyer in 1999/2000 and entered the new millennium complimented by rave reviews.

The large undulating greens ensure an idyllic yet challenging round of golf, being built over a gentle landscape that provides ease of walking. The signature hole is the 17th hole, which is a par 5. At 494m and stroke 2, this can be daunting especially when playing into the sea breeze.





Day 1: October 04, 2020

- Arrive at George Airport where you will be met by our representative
- Transfer to Gondwana Game Reserve and check in for 5 nights
- Take an afternoon game drive through the reserve, accompanied by a knowledgeable ranger who will share their expertise of the local flora and fauna while guiding you to sightings of the reserve's wildlife

- Play 1x 18 holes golf at Pinnacle Point Golf Course (Includes Green Fee, Halfway House, Golf Cart)
- Return to the lodge, where you'll enjoy an exclusive wine tasting experience before dinner
- Overnight at the Gondwana Game Reserve







Day 3: October 06, 2020

- Start the day early with a morning game drive through the reserve
- Return to the lodge for a well-deserved breakfast
- Play 1x 18 holes golf at **Mossel Bay Golf Estate Golf Course** (Includes Green Fee, Halfway House)
- Return to the lodge, where you'll be treated to a bush dinner with African drumming
- Overnight at the Gondwana Game Reserve







Day 4: October 07, 2020

- Start the day early with a morning game drive through the reserve.
- Return to the lodge for a well-deserved breakfast.
- Take the unique Naugu Challenge at Gondwana, a golf activity with an elevated tee.
- Depart on a final game drive through the reserve, during which you'll have the opportunity to spot some of the wildlife you have not yet encountered.
- Enjoy dinner at the lodge.
- Overnight at the Gondwana Game Reserve.







Day 5: October 08, 2020

- Enjoy breakfast at the lodge before departing for your final round of golf
- Play 1x 18 holes golf at **Pinnacle Point Golf Course** (Includes Green Fee, Halfway House, Golf Cart)
- Return to the lodge for a farewell dinner, during which the winner of the AGSI, and the prize buffalo, will be announced!
- Overnight at the Gondwana Game Reserve





Day 6: October 09, 2020

- Enjoy breakfast before checking out from the lodge and transfer to George Airport for your flight back home.
