

ACTIVITIES

Immerse yourself in an African adventure where you observe wildlife, explore wild places and get involved in hands-on volunteering.



CONSERVATION PROJECTS

Participate in projects that are key to protecting and maintaining Africa's biodiversity. Get your hands dirty and make a meaningful contribution to conservation goals.



WILDLIFE

This is a unique opportunity to observe a wide diversity of species in a big-5 game reserve (such as lions, rhinos and elephants) and to learn about less-known animals in the rivers and ocean.



DISCOVER

Immerse yourself in one of Africa's wild places through game drives, bush hikes, river paddling or exploring the nearby coast. This is an opportunity to have fun while connecting with nature.



COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

Engage with local communities, understand the relationship between communities and conservation and directly contribute to community projects. Give back while obtaining a deeper understanding of the local culture.


A UNIQUE STORY

Learn about Thandi on your adventure! Thandi, a female Southern white rhino, survived a gruesome poaching attack in 2012. In the local language isiXhosa, her name means "courage" and she recently became a grandmother.

Thandi is one of the few poaching success stories. Hundreds of rhinos are killed each year for their horns. You will meet the anti-poaching team, learn about their work and get a chance to track Thandi. This is conservation in action, being exposed to the realities on the ground, the everyday challenges and, the need for creative solutions.



WHY KARIEGA IN SOUTH AFRICA?



South Africa, on the continent's southern tip, is the 25th-largest country in the world, and boasts a lengthy coastline stretching more than 1,500 miles (almost 3000km) along two oceans. South Africa is one of the most biodiverse countries in the world, with many endemic plants and animals in unique and varied ecosystems. Almost 10% of South Africa's total land area is protected and managed for biodiversity conservation.

The Kariega Game Reserve is a 10,000 hectare protected wilderness area that was recovered from fifteen farms. This process began in the 1990s, and the resulting wilderness area is now an important sanctuary for the wildlife and biodiversity of the region. This program was developed in partnership with the Kariega Foundation, a non-profit organization that works closely with impoverished communities to create a sustainable balance between ecotourism, community rejuvenation and advanced conservation practices.

This program not only contributes to the conservation objectives of the wilderness area, but it also provides benefits to the local communities. Together, we aim to provide a meaningful nature-based adventure that gives back, and highlights the link between community and conservation.

DAY 1

Arrive in Johannesburg and transfer to the city of Gqeberha (Port Elizabeth) with a domestic flight, followed by a road transfer to Kariega Game Reserve. Settle into your new surroundings with a warm welcome and introduction to Kariega Conservation Centre.

An evening around the fire will provide a perfect opportunity to learn about the history and the Kariega conservation success story.

DAY 3

Contribute to natural resource management activities such as alien plant clearing and habitat restoration.

Activities are split between morning and afternoon sessions with a midday break and canoeing on the Bushman's River. This day focuses on learning about conservation projects and getting directly involved with the team on the ground.

A discussion with the ecologist will provide an overview of the reserve's objectives and clarify how your contribution is making an impact to their vision.



DAY 2

Embark on your first
game drive to identify
and observe Africa's
wildlife species while
being exposed to the
rich biodiversity of
the region. Meet the
anti-poaching K9 unit
and learn the story of
rhino Thandi. You will enjoy a
midday break, picnic lunch and swim in
the river.

Fireside chats with the anti-poaching team will provide insight into the challenges and successes of their work.

DAY 4

Today is an introduction to local culture,

communities living adjacent to the reserve and conservation issues. Work together with school children, help out with community gardens,

get involved in community projects, learn traditional sports and play a game of soccer! You will be treated to a traditional lunch and introduced to traditional dancing.



DAY 5

Spend the day on the coast and learn about marine ecology and the estuarine system. Identify intertidal species and explore the coastal zone, stopping for lunch and a swim in the sea. Hike the coastal trail, feel the sand between your toes and enjoy the beautiful ocean views.

If the weather allows, an evening of tidal pool exploration will be part of the experience!

DAY 7

Complete your adventure
with a final game
drive or bush walk,
learning the tracks
and signs of the bush
while being exposed
to both large and
small animals. After
lunch, prepare for your
departure back to Gqeberha (Port
Elizabeth) and your onward journey to
Johannesburg and then home.

DAY 6

Learn about permaculture and get your hands dirty with the indigenous plant nurseries and composting systems. In the afternoon, engage with local communities and assist with community gardens and plant indigenous trees. Make friends and make a lasting contribution!

Enjoy your evening around a fire under Africa's night sky.


