
OLD MAC DADDY TRAILER PARK | ELGIN VALLEY



Day to Day

Day 1

After arriving at Cape Town International
Airport, you will then be escorted to your
transfer vehicle for the short journey to Green
Point, which is less than an hour away. Green
Point is ideally located between Cape Town's
mountains and the Atlantic Ocean in one of the
city's stylish suburbs. After checking in and
freshening up, take a group walk to explore the
area before dinner. We have arranged a pizza
evening for you, and board games are
available for your entertainment.



Day 2

A thrilling day awaits as you prepare to meet your guides. Together, you will embark on a memorable journey to conquer the heights of Table Mountain, and later descend gracefully via cable car. This exhilarating activity will consume the entirety of your day. En route to your accommodation, a brief pit stop at a nearby supermarket will allow you to procure the necessary ingredients for tonight's dinner.





Day 3

After a satisfying breakfast, your day begins with an exhilarating half-day sandboarding adventure. Located just 40 minutes from Cape Town, the awe-inspiring Atlantis Dunes serves as the ideal playground for this thrilling activity, offering mesmerizing vistas and pristine white sand dunes that reach heights of up to 35 meters. Following the sandboarding fun, you will have a picnic lunch en route to the V&A Waterfront for a visit to Robben Island, a place steeped in South Africa's history, notably as Nelson Mandela's prison for 27 years. Before returning to the guesthouse, a quick stop for dinner ingredients will complete your day.



Day 5

Start your day with breakfast at The Barn at Old Mac Daddy. Afterward, embark on a roughly 4hour road journey to Gondwana Game Reserve. Upon your arrival at the reserve, a delectable lunch awaits, and you will then be transferred to the remote Tented Eco Camp. Once settled in, there will be time for a quick freshening up before indulging in afternoon tea and preparing for an exciting afternoon game drive. During the drive, observe wild buffalo and giraffe, study their behavior and feeding habits, and assess their environmental impact. As the day transitions to evening, you will enjoy sundowners and a breathtaking sunset before returning to camp. To cap off the day's adventures, welcome drinks will be served at the bar, followed by a satisfying dinner under the stars.



Day 4

Following breakfast, you will set out for an adventure in Grabouw, a scenic one-hour drive from Cape Town. Here, they will embark on an adrenaline-fueled ziplining adventure that promises thrills and breathtaking views. After the exhilarating ziplining experience, you will enjoy a light lunch and refreshments to rejuvenate the group. Later, you will be transferred to Old Mac Daddy Trailer Park, surrounded by the picturesque Elgin forest and landscape. Here, they can enjoy a variety of activities, including archery, mountain biking, nature walks, water sports, tractor rides, and more. Dining options include a restaurant offering pizzas, hamburgers, and chips, along with a traditional South African "Potjie kos" dinner to round off the day.



Day 6

Your day kicks off with an early game drive followed by breakfast. Get ready for an engaging day at Gondwana Private Game Reserve alongside dedicated conservationists. Participate in various activities, like tracking lions and observing elephant behavior. Contribute to projects like the Stealth Camera initiative and wildlife husbandry, focusing on rare species. Experience reserve challenges first-hand, such as anti-poaching, snare collection, and managing invasive plants. Dive into hands-on tasks alongside the conservation team. Enjoy a bush braai before an afternoon game drive. Afterward, relish refreshing drinks, followed by dinner with a briefing for tomorrow's activities. Wind down around the campfire before heading to your tent for a restful night's sleep.



Day to Day


Day 7

Today's schedule closely mirrors the previous day's activities during your stay at Gondwana Private Game Reserve. This includes participation in the Working for Water Program, focusing on wattle cutting and spraying to prevent regrowth in designated areas, as well as the Wetlands Assessment using Mini Sass to diagnose water quality and assess wetland health. The Stealth Camera checks will also continue. For those on the 5-day program, you will engage in a Game Census, concentrating on the migratory patterns of plains game. This involves recording vital data on game encountered, such as location, species, numbers, gender, age classes, behavior, movement, and condition, both during drives and on foot. Ad hoc activities may also arise, including game releases, game capture, and wildlife veterinary work. Lunch will be served at 1:00 PM. After your day in the field, return to camp for afternoon tea or drink, followed by an afternoon game drive. Upon returning, indulge in some drinks, followed by dinner. This evening will offer a delightful introduction to traditional African dishes, with an opportunity to participate in meal preparation and learn about the vibrant Xhosa culture. Briefing for tomorrow's activities will follow. Conclude your day with some time around the campfire before retiring to your tent for a restful night's sleep.









Day 8












FACTS ON SOME OF THE ANIMALS YOU MAY SEE:



SOUTHETEN RIGHT WHALE:

Known for their distinctive callosities, which are rough white patches of skin. These patterns are formed by parasitic whale lice, which cluster on the callosities, they are unique to each individual whale.



They are known for their long, bright orange bills, which are perfectly adapted for their unique feeding habits. They use their bills to probe into sand and mud to find and extract various invertebrates.





CAPE SUGATZEBITZD:

Cape sugarbirds are known for their exceptionally long tail feathers, which can extend more than twice the length of their bodies. These long, elegant tail feathers are often used in intricate aerial displays during courtship rituals.

PROTEA FLOWETZS:

Many protea species are adapted to thrive in regions prone to wildfires. It is not only celebrated for its striking and unique appearance but is also of great cultural and national significance in South Africa.





CAPE PYNBOS:

Fynbos is known for its stunning and diverse array of flowers, which bloom at different times of the year.

These plants have adapted to the region's specific environmental conditions, including nutrient-poor soils and periodic wildfires.

ROCK HYTZAXES

They are known for their social behavior and are often seen basking in the sun on rocky outcrops. Despite their rodent-like appearance, rock hyraxes are more closely related to elephants and manatees than to rodents.





THE GHZAFFE:

Giraffes have incredibly large hearts, weighing up to 24 pounds. Despite their impressive size and long necks, giraffes are generally gentle and non-aggressive animals. They are herbivores, primarily feeding on leaves.

THE LION:


Lions are apex predators and primarily prey on large mammals. The mane serves as a symbol of strength and dominance among males and also provides some protection during fights.


