

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

# A: Ljubljana

Surrounded by picturesque hills, the Ljubljanica River flows through the city, giving it a charming waterfront. The city has a rich history dating back to Roman times when it was known as Emona.

#### C: Nova Gorica



# Day 3

Following breakfast, your journey continues as you drive to the Olympic Sport Center in Kranjska Gora. This renowned facility serves as a hub for the Slovenian national basketball team and European clubs during their training camps. After settling in, enjoying a satisfying lunch, and a bit of relaxation time, your basketball training camp kicks off with an afternoon training session. During your stay in Kranjska Gora, you will experience the full routine of sleep, meals, training, and relaxation, mirroring the experience of the Slovenian national team.

## Day 5

In the area around our basketball camp, you will discover a range of activities suitable for both basketball enthusiasts and those seeking nonbasketball experiences. For basketball enthusiasts, we offer friendly matches, skills workshops, and basketball history tours. For those looking to diversify their experiences, enjoy a serene stroll to Lake Jasna, paddle boating on the lake, or explore the surroundings on bicycles. Hiking trails in the nearby mountains offer breathtaking vistas, and local restaurants provide a taste of regional cuisine. Our camp aims to provide a well-rounded experience catering to diverse interests.

# Day 7

In the morning, we can opt for either a training session or a lecture. Afterward, you head to Lake Bled, before continuing to Lake Bohinj. Here, you will stop for lunch with a taste of typical Slovenian stew. In the afternoon, you will enjoy a group activity on Lake Bohinj, such as kayaking, a hike to a nearby waterfall, or a cable car ride to the mountains for stunning views.





Your training camp promises a full day of basketball immersion. You kick off the morning with intensive training, focusing on refining your on-court skills and fostering

teamwork. In the afternoon, you have a unique opportunity to learn from a distinguished Slovenian basketball expert. This insightful session covers a range of crucial topics, including physical preparation, tactical strategies, pre-game routines, injury prevention, offensive and defensive methods, and in-depth game analysis. These discussions will enhance your basketball abilities but also provide a comprehensive understanding of the sport.

# Day 6

In the morning, you continue your basketball training. After lunch, you will visit the famous Planica valley with one of the world's largest ski jumps. Later, you will explore a tranquil spring of the Sava River, Slovenia's largest river.

You will conclude the day with dinner and an overnight stay at Lake Jasna.

### Day 8

After an early breakfast, you will drive through the Vršič Pass, enjoying the scenic Soča Valley. Here, you will embark on a short hike to either the source of the Soča River or the enchanting Kozjak waterfall. In Kobarid, you delve into World War I history and visit the "Od planine do Planike" dairy museum for a fascinating cheese-making history presentation and tasting. In the afternoon, you can choose between visiting the Tolmin Gorge, known for

it's natural beauty, or enjoying an easy rafting group activity.

# Day 10

Following a hearty breakfast, your adventure continues with an exploration of the coastal gem, Zadar – the historic capital of Byzantine Dalmatia. As we wander through the charming Old City, you will be treated to captivating sights, including the awe-inspiring Church of St.

Donatus, the Bishop's Palace, and the intriguing remains of the town square. Afterwards you will pay a visit to a local basketball court, a place where the legendary Dražen Petrović honed his skills as a child. There may be an opportunity for a basketball seminar, training session, or a friendly game with the local team. You wrap up the day with a delightful

day with a delightful dinner and an overnight stay in the area.



After breakfast, your journey leads you to Croatia's first national park, the expansive Plitvice National Park, which holds the distinction of being the largest among Croatia's eight national parks. Recognized for its "outstanding natural beauty and undisturbed production of travertine (tufa) through chemical and biological action," it proudly stands as a UNESCO World Heritage Site. You will enjoy a late lunch or early dinner at a local restaurant before traveling to Zagreb for our final night's stay. The following day, after breakfast, you will embark on a captivating tour of Zagreb, the capital of Croatia. Our exploration begins at the vibrant Ban Jelačić Square and continues to the Upper Town, where you will experience the charm of Old Zagreb. Along the way, you will visit prominent landmarks such as the Cathedral, the City Museum, the Dolac Market, the Stone Gate, the Gallery of Naive Art, and St. Mark's Church. In the afternoon, you will make your way to Zagreb Airport, where you will bid your farewells, concluding our memorable journey.
