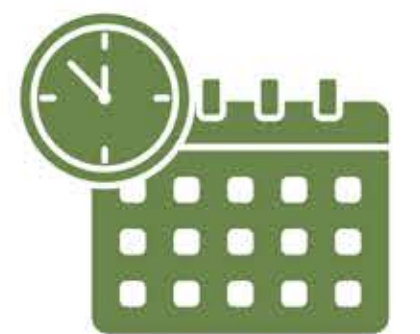

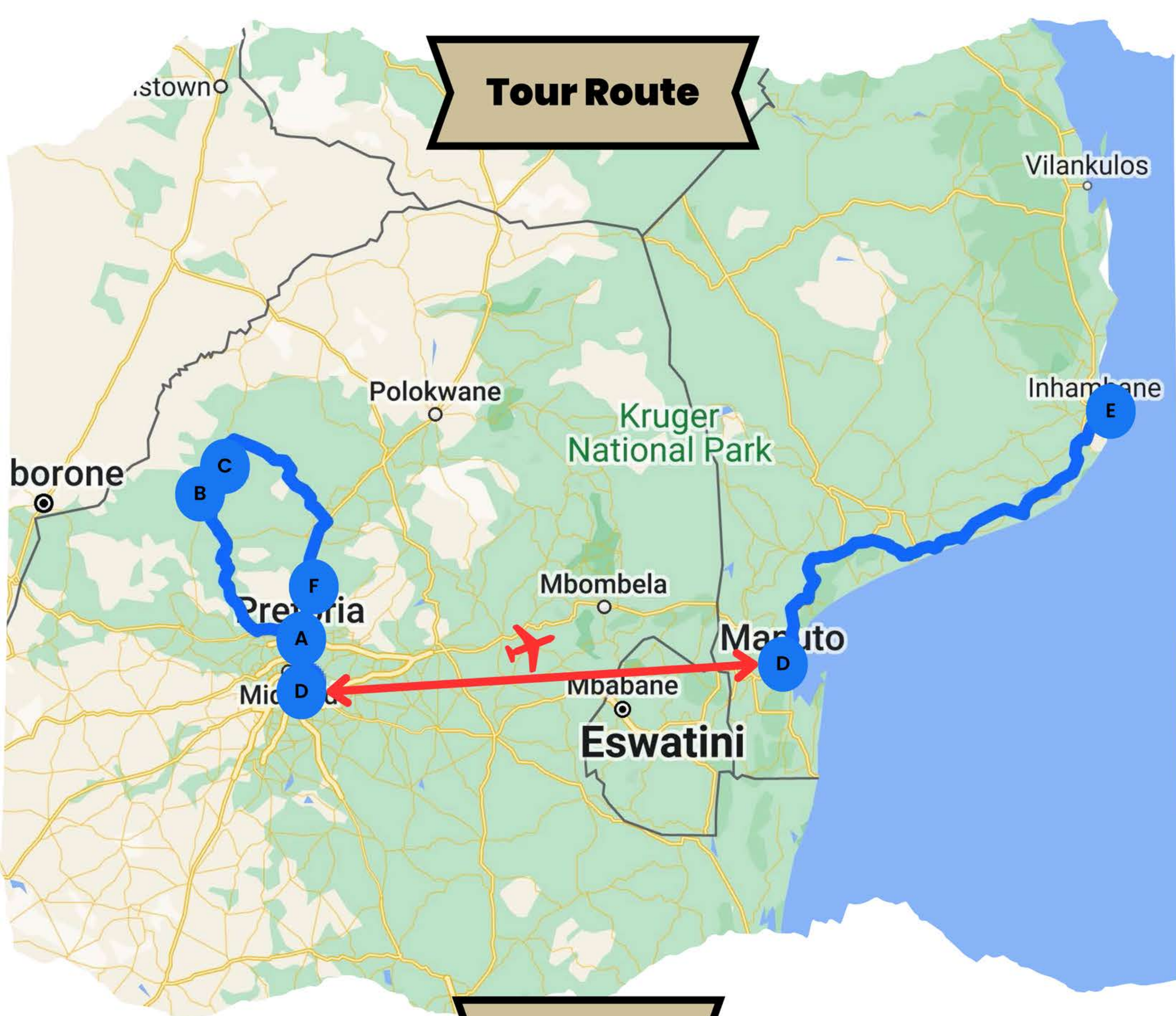

Day 1

Upon your late evening arrival at O.R. Tambo International Airport, our driver will meet you right after customs and baggage claim. The transfer to the Airport Lodge is a quick 20-minute drive, and you will be welcomed with warm pizza and refreshing water upon arrival.



Day 2

You start the day with an early breakfast at the Airport Lodge, followed by check-out. At 07:30 AM, the Spurwing driver takes you to Thabang Children's Centre. Upon arrival, your team leaders will introduce you to the contractors for your fire pit and painting project. Once you wrap up your work at Thabang Children's Project by 4:00 PM, you will then take a 20-minute road transfer to Rossouwspoor. After arrival, you can enjoy a hike led by group leaders or a 4x4 mountain trail. After dinner, you gather around a campfire to relax and enjoy the evening.



Day to Day

Day 3

You start your day with a hearty cooked breakfast. Afterward, you depart from Rossouwspoot and head to the Thabang Children's Centre for your community service project. The day will be dedicated to meaningful community service work, with contractors providing guidance and instruction throughout. You wrap up your activities at Thabang around 4:00 PM. Once back at Rossouwspoot, you can choose to enjoy a variety of activities. As the day draws to a close, you will gather around a campfire for dinner.



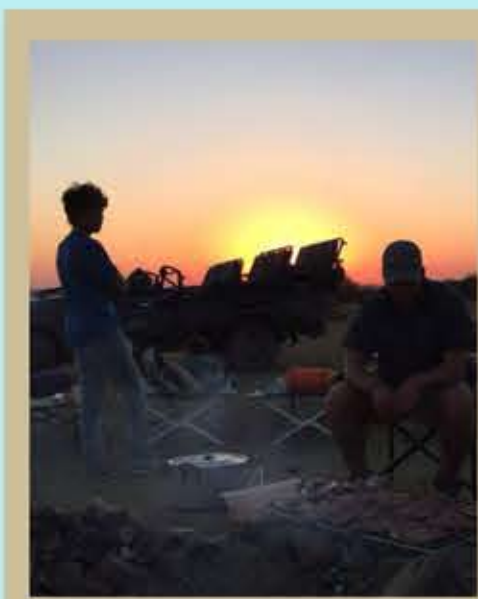
Day 5

After brunch, you prepare for Elephant Camp activities, including animal tracking, conservation discussions, team-building exercises, and more. Enjoy a light lunch and a late afternoon game drive with sundowners. Evening meals will be served around the campfire. Activities like sleeping under the stars and Rhino darting are weather-dependent for flexibility.



Day 7

The adventure continues with an early morning game drive, emphasizing survival skills and bushcraft. You will learn crucial wilderness survival techniques like finding food, purifying water, using medicinal plants, and exploring African folklore in preparation for an evening under the stars in the wilderness. You then head to the Mambo area, known for frequent wildlife sightings. After setting up camp, and starting a slow-burning fire, members will collaborate to cook dinner on the fire and sleep on ground mats beneath the stars.



Day 4

You will engage in another round of community service at Thabang before setting off for an Elephant Camp in Marataba. Upon arrival, an exciting game drive awaits, with the added thrill of enjoying sundowners in the wilderness from a picturesque vantage point. Afterwards a welcome braai (BBQ) awaits.



Day 6

Your day starts with an early morning game drive, followed by a nourishing breakfast. Your midday session will focus on animal tracks, tracking, and general animal behavior. Following that, you will apply your newfound tracking skills in the field. This activity encompasses both driving and walking through the vast game country, where you will identify animal signs and track large game.



Day 8

On your last day at Elephant Camp - Marataba, enjoy an early morning game drive at 06:00 AM with coffee as you soak in the stunning African sunrise. After brunch, our Spurwing driver will pick you up at 11:00 AM for the four-hour drive back to Airport Lodge. Prepare for an early morning flight to Mozambique the next day.



Day 9

Indulge in a light breakfast before your journey back to OR Tambo International Airport. Upon your arrival at Inhambane Airport, the Tofo Scuba team will warmly welcome you and provide transportation to Tofo. You will be greeted and treated to a delightful dinner at the house.



Day to Day

Day 10



After breakfast, you will split into two groups. Group one will start their morning with a scuba diving session in a pool and an ocean safari, while Group two will start their

day with a morning ocean safari and later enjoy a surf lesson. After a day filled with sun and water adventures, both groups will reconvene at the lodge for dinner, which you will have the pleasure of preparing yourselves.

Day 11



Today, the groups will switch activities. Group one will start with a morning ocean safari and a surf lesson later in the morning. Group two, on the other hand, will have their pool session in the morning and their session in the afternoon. For

dinner, you will once again take charge, using fresh ingredients provided by the Tofo Scuba team.

Day 12

You will start the day off with an early morning surfing lesson. Afterwards, you will go on an exciting cultural trip and a cooking lesson. After lunch, everyone can anticipate a captivating Dhow sunset cruise. Dinner will be a group effort back at the lodge, with participants taking charge of meal preparation. As the night falls, the group will gather around the campfire for some consolidation and storytelling, cherishing their last night in Mozambique.



Day 14+15

Begin your day with an early morning game drive, accompanied by a refreshing cup of coffee or tea, allowing you to savor the exquisite African sunrise. Upon your return to camp, indulge in a traditional cooked English breakfast. For lunch, a light meal of sandwiches and salads will be served, followed by a late afternoon game drive, with a picturesque stop in the bush for sundowners. After witnessing the sunset, return to camp for a delightful dinner and some relaxation around the campfire. The following day marks your last early morning wake-up call in Africa, greeted by coffee and rusks to kickstart your day positively. Embrace an early morning game walk, once again accompanied by a soothing cup of coffee, as you soak in your final African sunrise. Following this, return to camp for a traditional cooked English breakfast.



Day 13

Following breakfast, you will pack up your belongings and travel via road transfer from Tofo to Inhambane Airport for your flight. Upon your late evening arrival at OR Tambo, you will have a road transfer to Little Mongena Tented Camp, which is just over an hour away. Upon check-in and a brief orientation, a warm welcome awaits with a barbecue (braai) in the boma area.
