A: Bakuriani

Bakuriani is a beautiful and picturesque mountain resort town. The history is rich with Archaeological evidence that dates back centuries. The region has been inhabited since ancient times.

C: Kvabiskhevi

This is a gorgeous camp site, surrounded by popular tourist attractions such as the Kvatakhevi Monastery, Mariamtsminda and Datvisjvari Pass.

E:Tbilisi




F: Lagodekhi National Park

The National Park spans 5000 square kilometers and is home to a diverse range of wildlife. You can encounter magnificent creatures like the Caucasian deer, chamois, forest cats, and even a lynx! More than 215 bird species and 30 animal species live in these forests.

Today includes a visit to a local organic farm in Barbale. Before work, you will have a meeting with the farm owners who will share insights into their farm's maintenance. After a fulfilling day of work, dinner will be provided by Barbale farm.




Day 13


cliffs.





Day 11








Day 14+15





