
Day 1

Training and handling these furry companions, along with shared yard upkeep, will be your daily tasks. Guided hikes will introduce you to the trails, beaches, and the lay of the land.





Day to Day

Day 3

Today you will learn a lot about nature. After breakfast and dog training, your guide will take you for a walk around Engholm Husky Design Lodge . Here, you'll learn about plants that serve as food, tools, and medicine. You will pick some plants and create useful tools, delicious drinks, and meals. Additionally, you will acquire fire-

making and food preparation skills.



Day 5

Today promises an exhilarating adventure with an exploration of diverse terrains and a thrilling "gold hunt." Embarking on a canoeing expedition along the Karasjohka River, we will take breaks at several beautiful beaches. Among the exciting activities is the chance to try your hand at gold panning, and who knows, you might just strike gold!

Today, we are off on a guided trip to Karasjok, the Norwegian Sàmi capital, where around 90% speak Sami. With about 60,000 reindeer in the area, we will explore the Sàmi Museum of Contemporary Art and visit the Sami Parliament. Additionally, we will have a chance to purchase Sàmi



Day 4



Having mastered dog handling, you will be able to enjoy the scenic views while learning map and compass navigation. The program also covers essential first aid training for handling emergencies in nature.

Day 6

Today will include a hike to one of the nearby lakes, where we will have the opportunity to fish for arctic char and trout using our fishing gear. Once we have successfully caught our fresh catch,



we will prepare the fish over an open fire.

Day 8

Today we will learn about reindeer herding from a dedicated reindeer herder. The Sami herders consider it a year-round commitment with eight distinct seasons, each demanding various tasks due to the effects of climate change. After this insightful experience, we will be introduced to joik, the traditional Sámi way of singing and chanting, where we will have the opportunity to learn and enjoy some songs.

Day 9

There will be a brief introduction from the guide

before starting our overnight trip. We will hike through beautiful forest scenery, alongside the lake and river, engage in fishing and learn outdoor life skills. Our destination is Ravnastua mountain, where we will stay in a cabin, tent, or under the spectacular open sky.

Today, we will enjoy hiking, fishing, and practicing outdoor life skills on the rolling landscape of the Finnmark Plateau. Lunch and dinner will be served around a roaring camp fire.

Day 12

Indulge in a delightful breakfast served right in the comfort of your cabin. Make the most of this precious last full day with activities around Engholm Husky Design Lodge, ensuring you savour every moment. As the day draws to a close, a special farewell dinner awaits, where you will have

the pleasure of dining with the gracious hosts of Engholm Husky Design Lodge and the wonderful team at Turgleder.


Day 13

This phenomenon is caused by charged particles from the sun colliding with the Earth's atmosphere, creating beautiful colors like green, pink, red, yellow, blue, and purple that are seen in the night sky.

History

The history is closely tied to its Viking past. Vikings were seafaring warriors who explored and settled in various parts of Europe. In the 14th century, Norway became part of the Kalmar Union.

Food

Norway is known for its abundance of fresh seafood due to its long coastline. They also have a variety of other foods such as Fiskesuppe (Fish Soup) ,Kjøttboller (Norwegian Meatballs), Brunost (Brown Cheese) and Multekrem: A dessert made from cloudberries and cream.



Culture

Norway's cultural history is deeply rooted in its Viking past, which spans from the 8th to 11th centuries. Constitution Day (17th of May) is Norway's most significant celebration, commemorating the country's independence and marked by parades and festivities.

Reindeer

These reindeer undergo seasonal migrations between the coastal areas in the winter and the inland areas in the summer. Norway has one of the last remaining populations of wild reindeer in Europe and herding them has been a crucial part of the Sami culture and economy.


Museums
